#### SAFETY NOTES

- 1. This part should ONLY be fitted by suitably qualified persons having technical competence, applicable product knowledge and suitable tools and test equipment.
- 2. Servicing of electrical appliances must be undertaken with the appliance disconnecte (unplugged) from the electrical supply.
- 3. Servicing must be preceded by Earth continuity and Insulation Resistance checks.
- 4. Personal safety precautions must be taken to protect against accidents caused by sharp edges on metal and plastic parts.
- 5. After servicing, the appliance must be rechecked for Electrical Safety.

#### **HEATER CUT-OUTS**

Heater cut-outs are *safety devices* which ensure correct operating temperatures of the appliance.

If either the 'One-Shot' cut-out or the 'Auto-Reset' cut-out fail, both must be replaced.

The cut-outs are only available in kits. Illustrations are provided overleaf to help you select the correct part numbers. Terminal configurations, temperatures of the cut-outs contained in the kits and the appliance 'type' are also shown. Reference should also be made to the relevant Service Manual to cross check the part number.

#### NOTE: -

Care should be taken to identify the correct wiring and position of each type of failed cut -out or the appliance before effecting any repair as it is **essential** for appliance safety.

Because of the temperature variation of these components, it is *crucial* that the correct kit is used. Failure to do so will constitute a *safety hazard*.
